

phrase -- a group of words that doesn't contain a subject and a verb and functions as a single part of speech in a sentence.

clause -- a group of words that contains a subject and a verb and may or may not have a complete thought.

1. independent clause -- a clause with a complete thought
2. dependent clause -- a clause without a complete thought

conjunction -- is a word(s) that join words, phrases, or clauses together.

coordinating conjunction -- joins words, phrases, or clauses of equal value.
